### SPONSORSHIP

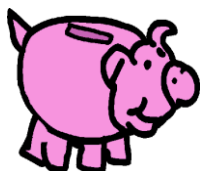

The purpose of this is to reduce the need to purchase additional ingredients and use all of which is so generously donated. ## PRESERVES

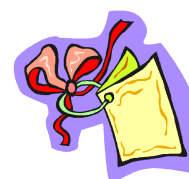
