



SPECIALIST GROUP CLASSES

Dress Up & Drama: 4 – 6 yrs
Role Play, Voice Production, Mime, Poetry, Story Telling, Movement. Cost \$90 per term for 45 minute class, maximum of 10 students per class.



Speech & Drama: 6 yrs – adult
Poetry, Characterisation, Reading Aloud, Group Drama, Role Play, Story Telling, Mime, Mask and Theatre Sports. Cost \$210 per term 6 – 14 years, \$230 per term 14 yrs and above, maximum of 4 students per class.

Public Speaking & Communication: 6 yrs – adult
Social Speaking, Formal Speeches, Impromptu Speaking, Motivational Speaking, Interviewing. Cost \$210 per term 6 – 14 years, \$230 per term 14 yrs and above, maximum of 4 students per class.

Oral Assessment & Vocational Speaking: 6 yrs – adult
On request.

These classes are held in the studio in Palmerston North or at several different schools around the region. Check out our website for current school locations.

INDIVIDUAL CLASSES

Classes are arranged as required. Students may have a special event or presentation coming up, a school NCEA presentation or social speaking engagement. Cost: \$65 per hour (adults welcome).

HOLIDAY PROGRAMMES

Holiday Programmes are held every school holidays for students aged 8 years and above. Industry professionals are employed to deliver each programme. Check out the website for the full details on the next holiday programme.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

- Q:** What if I am shy and quiet, will classes help me?
A: Yes, yes, yes... our programmes develop confidence and before you know it, you will be a star!
- Q:** Can I pay for the classes one at a time?
A: You have to enrol for a full term, however for a small administration fee you can elect to pay via automatic payment weekly or fortnightly. Family discount is also available.
- Q:** When are the class times?
A: Classes run all week from 3.30 – 9pm. Once you have made the decision to join Tall Poppies Drama School you commit to that class time for the term/year.
- Q:** Am I able to come and see/try a class before I commit?
A: Yes, just contact us and we will advise you of a suitable time to come and join in.
- Q:** Do I have to sit exams and enter competitions?
A: Certainly not. These are optional extras and you make the decision to do this with your family. There is no pressure to enter.
- Q:** Can I come and watch my child during class?
A: Most of our classes are for a couple of classes or until your child is comfortable. We have a special class for students with just the class in the studio. There will be many opportunities throughout the year for your child to share their work.
- Q:** Will there be homework and if so how much?
A: We expect about 15 minutes a week of preparation for class. This can include memorising lines or creating visual aids for talks.
